

Opening ceremony:

Thursday, September 1st, 2016:

From 18h30:

- Welcome of the participants by the Club and the CdL representative, European anthem and rising of the FCI flag.
- Opening ceremony and presentation of the nations (team leaders, officials and participants/dogs are invited to attend the ceremony).
- Aperitif will be served to welcome the participants followed by a musical program.

Veterinary control - Deposit of the notebooks - Measurements of sizes:

Veterinary control is possible only the day before the race.

- Dogs running Friday: Thursday between 15h00 and 17h30
- Dogs running Saturday: Friday between 15h00 and 17h30
- Dogs running Sunday: Saturday between 15h00 and 17h30

For foreigner dogs, a valid vaccination certificate against rabies will be required. Please acknowledge the regulations on the conditions of introduction and the transport of domestic carnivores in France. Any violation of the regulations will conduct to the eviction of the owner and its animals.

Beginning of the races:

Friday, September the 2nd, 2016 – 08h30

Breeds: Azawakh, Borzoi, Deerhound, Galgo Español, Irish wolfhound, Pharaoh hound, Podenco, Cirneco, Sloughi, Italien Greyhound.

Saturday, September the 3rd, 2016 – 08h00

Breeds: Afghan hound, Magyar Agár, Saluki, Greyhound.

Sunday, September the 4th, 2016 – 08h00

Breed: Whippet

According to the number of inscriptions, the Steering Committee reserves the right to make run one or more breeds another day. The final distribution of the breeds will be published at the latest the 13 august 2016.

Distances:

Italian Greyhounds & Whippets	347 m
Other breeds	477 m

Track - Lure - Finish:

Oval - chord radius 44 m - width of track 7 m - track in sands with watering - banked corners - lure drawn by thermal engine on rail - Omega photo finish.

Regulations:

Regulation of FCI races and application of directives of FCI championships.

Additional information: muzzle is mandatory for all breeds except for Italian Greyhounds.

Dogs must be on leash at all time.

France will comply with the international racing regulations sent to all CDL delegates on 17 December 2015 by the President, Hubert Iser, and in particular article 1.5.3.

Additional Sighthound events 1.5.3

For dogs exceeding the size stated under 1.4.2, a solution must be found at National Organization level to permit these dogs to participate in Sighthound events.

A friendly race can be organized for these dogs at the World or European Championship. The Winner of this friendly race obtains the title of "CDL Sprinter Champion 2XXX (year)".

Each country therefore has a choice, and the organization of this "friendly" event is not in any way compulsory. Also, France will not be organizing a "Sprinter" friendly event in the context of the World Racing Championship 2016.

Admission:

Maximum of 12 sighthounds by country, breed and sex.

The 2014 champions can defend their title quota-free of the 12 dogs.

The dog must have run without disqualification the two last races before the end of the inscriptions for the championship.

A disqualification between the inscription closure and the championship, excludes any participation.

For the World Racing Championship 2016 in Toulouse, the French Kennel Club (SCC) has given an exemption to all participants (except for the French) and only for that event.

The foreign delegations who will be taking part in this event will therefore be exempted from licence fees.

Decision CdL:

According to the decision of the CdL all Whippets and Italian Greyhounds which are not recorded in the database will be submitted to a measurement of size. This control will take place in parallel of the veterinary control. The delegate of the CdL is entitled to exclude from participation in the World championship all the dogs the size of which does not correspond to the one recommended by the FCI regulation.

The owners who refuse the size measurement are automatically excluded from participation in the World championship. No appeal against the decision of the delegates of the CdL is possible. By his commitment, every participant acquaints with the decision of the CdL.

Dope testing:

According to the FCI regulation, doping tests will be done during the three days of races.

Responsibility:

The organizer and the officials will not take responsibility in the event of an accident arising to owners, officials or sighthounds. They are not either responsible in case a sighthound escapes. Besides, the owner of a dog is not responsible in the case his sighthound hurts another sighthound during the race. For all other cases, the owner is kept totally responsible for his sighthound.

If the Championships must be cancelled by case of absolute necessity, the organizer is not held responsible and will not have to pay off expenses caused for the competitors or the teams.

→ From Bordeaux/Montauban A62: after toll, take the highway direction airport, exit n°33a.

Take the direction Lac de Sesquières et direction Rupé on the right, then across the Campanile hotel, take on the right, made the turn of the roundabout (2nd exit), street Jean Gilbert, direction rupé, continue on the chemin de fenouillet. The track is on your left shortly after AMERICAFER (on the right).

→ From Montpellier/Carcassonne A61, Albi A62: take the highway (A612) direction Bordeaux/Montauban and airport, take exit n°33a.

Take the direction Lac de Sesquières et direction Rupé on the right, then across the Campanile hotel, take on the right, made the turn of the roundabout (2nd exit), street Jean Gilbert, direction rupé, continue on the chemin de fenouillet. The track is on your left shortly after AMERICAFER (on the right).

→ From Tarbes/Foix A64, Blagnac airport: highway (A620) direction Bordeaux/Montauban, take exit Sesquières n°33b. Search for direction Lac Sesquières and Rupé. Across the Campanile hotel, take on the right, made the turn of the roundabout (2nd exit), street Jean Gilbert, and direction rupé, continue on the chemin de fenouillet. The track is on your left shortly after AMERICAFER (on the right).

Reminder on the conditions of introduction of domestic carnivores in France:

Travelling to France with Cats / Dogs / Ferrets, from a country in the European Union

Animals must have:

1 - Identification: animals must be identified by a microchip (electronic identification system) or by a clearly readable tattoo (applied before 3 July 2011) to travel within the EU.

2 - A valid vaccination against rabies given at a minimum age of 12 weeks (for animals vaccinated from 29/12/2014) (first vaccination and boosters).

First vaccinations are deemed to be valid after at least 21 days.

3 - A passport issued by a veterinary surgeon accredited by the competent authority, certifying the animal's identification and rabies vaccination.

Passports issued from 29/12/2014 must comply with the new passport (new features include: improved security for the animal identification page, which is now covered with a transparent film, and indication of start and end of validity dates for rabies vaccinations). There is no need to replace passports issued before 29/12/2014.

Important: Domestic carnivores (dogs, cats, ferrets) that are under three months old AND do not have a valid vaccination against rabies cannot be brought into France.

If the animal is not travelling with its owner, the person transporting it must possess **written authorization to transport the animal issued by its owner.**

Travelling with more than 5 dogs, cats, ferrets: additional requirements apply

From 6 dogs, cats, ferrets, in addition to the above requirements, it is necessary:

- to have a veterinary surgeon accredited by the competent authority perform a physical examination of the animal within 48 hours prior to the departure time. This visit is recorded by the veterinary surgeon in the pet passport in the "Physical examination" section,
- to obtain and travel with an official certificate issued by the veterinary authorities of the country of origin (TRACES certificate).
- Authorized means of transport.

Exemption when taking part in a show, a competition or a sporting event, and only in this context, an exemption from these additional requirements exists if: the animals are aged over 6 months **AND** the owner has a registration document for the event (dates / place of participation / animals entered / identification).

This registration document may also be supplemented by certification by the owner.

When returning to another Member State ensure that there are no other requirements to be fulfilled.
